















What makes a sexual orientation?

- Sexual orientation is an internal mechanism that directs one's sexual and romantic disposition to females, males, or both (Levay & Baldwin, 2012)






Is self-identification as asexual sufficient for classifying it as a unique sexual orientation?

Conclusions • preliminary support for at least a subgroup with a paraphilic characterization • modest support for as exuality's placement as a unique sexual orientation • as much variability among asexual individuals' lack of sexual attraction as there is among sexual individuals' • future research should aim at exploring the possibility for asexual subtypes
